Information and Guidelines

Please read the following guidelines carefully. The permission form is not valid unless ALL signature blanks are completed. Tickets may not be purchased without signed and completed permission form. Each Kalaheo student may bring only one guest who is 20 years old or younger.

- Get your obligations paid before ticket sales begins. All school fees and obligations must be paid and cleared during recess
 or lunch at the accounting window in H-building courtyard. *If you have obligations*, bring your permission form with
 you to the account clerk when you pay your obligations to receive an official stamp for financial clearance so we
 can allow you to buy a ticket or bring the receipt to show you paid the obligation. You must have your student ID with
 you to pay your obligations.
- 2. Ticket sales will be held in the Student Activities Center (C102) during recess and lunch. A current Kalaheo student I.D. card is required to purchase tickets. Tickets are sold on a first come, first-served basis.

4. Guests must be 20 years or younger and bring a valid government issued picture I.D.card when they arrive at the event. Kalaheo students must have their school I.D.

- 5. Buffet menu includes pot roast beef, soy glazed chicken, vegetable chow mein noodles, white rice, caesar salad, freshly baked rolls, and chef selection of desserts. Students and guests with special dietary needs must indicate this on the permission form. We will do our best to resonably accommodate any special dietary needs.
- 6. Table sign-ups begin on November 19 and end on November 21. Download the table sign-up form at the Kalaheo web site (www.kalaheohigh.org) and turn in completed form to Mr. Lau's box. No changes will be allowed. The committee will assign students to tables who do not sign up. A student and their guest must sign up for the same table. You may not sign up people on your table without their consent.
- 6. ALL Chapter 19 and school rules will apply throughout the event for students and guests. Kalaheo students are responsible for communicating school rules and event guidelines to their guests.
- 7. Kalaheo students must NOT have been suspended from school on December 19 and January 8 in order to attend The event. A suspension will result in cancellation of the tickets (student and guest) and no refund will be issued.
- 8. Once a ticket has been purchased, there will be absolutely **no refund**.
- The doors open at 6:00pm. Check-in will be from 6:00pm-6:45pm. Dinner will begin at 7:00pm. Do not be late. No one will be allowed into the ballroom after 7:00pm. No exceptions. No refunds given. If you will be late due to a school sponsored activity, you must inform Mr. Lau in C102 before December 19. Guests must check in with the sponsoring Kalaheo student.
- 10. A current Kalaheo student I.D. card is required to purchase tickets and to enter the event. A government issued picture I.D. card is required from guests. NO PROPER ID CARD MEANS NO ENTRY.
- 11. Backpacks, large bags, and packages will NOT be permitted into the event. Do not bring any contraband items including weapons, alcohol, cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, or other drugs. Please refer to Kalaheo Disciplinary Handbook for more clarification.
- 12. All students and guests are required to stay for entire duration of the event. Students leaving the event before 10:00pm will be suspended for insubordination effective Janurary 8. Once you and your guest leave the event you will not be allowed to return and the school is absolved of all responsibility.
- DRESS CODE for the Winter Dance is Dressy Attire. Attire will be strictly monitored at the door. Anyone not in appropriate attire will not be allowed to attend the event. No refunds given. If you are unsure about your outfit, please bring it to Mr. Lau in C102 for approval.
